1	Course objectives	The goal of the course is to acquire a good knowledge of the main concepts and techniques of linear algebra and analytical geometry.
2	Course content and learning outcomes (dublin descriptors)	<p>Topics of the module include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Matrices. Matrix operations. Determinants. Matrix inversion. Rank of a matrix. Kronecker theorem. Linear systems. Rouchè-Capelli theorem. Cramer theorem. Gaussian elimination algorithm. Cartesian coordinates. Vectors. Scalar and vector product. Mixed product. Plane geometry. Conics. Space geometry, lines, planes and their relative position. Vector spaces, subspaces. Linear combinations. Linear dependence and independence. Systems of generators. Basis and dimension. Linear transformations. Null space and range. Nullity plus rank theorem. Matrix representation of linear transformations. Change of basis. Similar matrices. Eigenvalues and eigenvectors. Eigenspace. Characteristic polynomial.
